IBAO Sponsors Promising Golfer for Third Year in a Row

TORONTO, March 13, 2009, The Insurance Brokers Association of Ontario (IBAO) is proud to announce today that it is renewing its sponsorship agreement with Kingsville, Ontario professional golfer Richard Scott.

25 year-old Richard Scott turned professional in November 2006 after having won three Canadian Men's Amateur Golf Championships and becoming only the sixth player in over 100 years to win three titles. In his second season on the Canadian Tour, the young golfer boasted three Top 10 finishes. This past year Scott tied for 5th spot at the Canadian Tour Players Cup held in Winnipeg and tied for 5th again at the TELUS Edmonton Open in July. He recently placed 4th at the Jane Rogers Championship of Mississauga.

Scott tied for 12th spot during the first stage of the PGA Qualifying School held in McKinney, Texas. Improving on his performance from last year in the second stage where Scott tied for 29th place, Scott just missed the cut for the final round finishing with 8-under 280 in a tie for 21st - one spot shy of qualifying.

“We are thrilled to continue this great partnership,” said IBAO CEO Randy Carroll. “Richard has joined our brokers at many charitable events and continues to support our ongoing partnership with OSAID. He’s a wonderful role model for students across the province and we wish him great success this season.”

Scott has been very involved in IBAO’s partnership with Ontario Students Against Impaired Driving (OSAID) where he has been an OSAID spokesperson encouraging students to play an active role in their high schools and the many OSAID programs across the province.

“I’m excited about the coming season and I am so proud to work with such a great group of community-minded individuals.” said Richard Scott.
